NEW Emergency Action Plan

Before you head out on the water, ALL MEMBERS should review the new UVRF Emergency Action Plan that is posted on the trailer. This is especially important now, while the water is dangerously cold, running fast and washing tree limbs downstream. Reminder: The red defibrillator box is to the left of the ramp.

COLD WATER ROWING

Rowers who want to row as soon as the Kendal dock is installed can find thermometers in the water-on the left side of the ramp near where it meets the dock, and at the downstream end of the dock.
